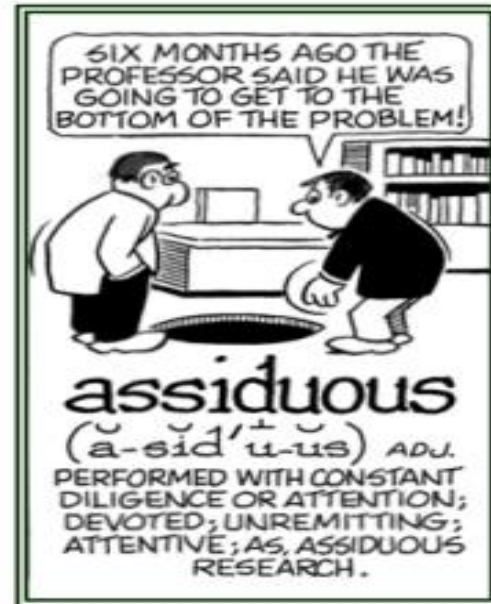

# Venerable

*Adjective.* Accorded a great deal of respect, especially because of age, wisdom, or character.
